



Do you create side trees in the same way? Not exactly! Side trees have to be planned in advance of threading the loom. They're created in the threading and when the bottom trees are treadled, the side trees will also appear. Here's the same snowball as before:




For the upright trees, the trunk was created from Block A. For the side trees, however, it will be Block C that forms the tree trunks. Watch the whole tree grow sideways now. **C3** ■





When the bottom trees are treadled, not only are the side trees activated, too, but crossed pine trees automatically appear in the corners. **D17** ■



For me, pre-planning the side trees is a little trickier than treadling the upright ones. You must be on guard or you'll invert the side trees and create a coverlet like this one: **D18, P5** ■
